96 Young St., Brighton • 613-475-2144

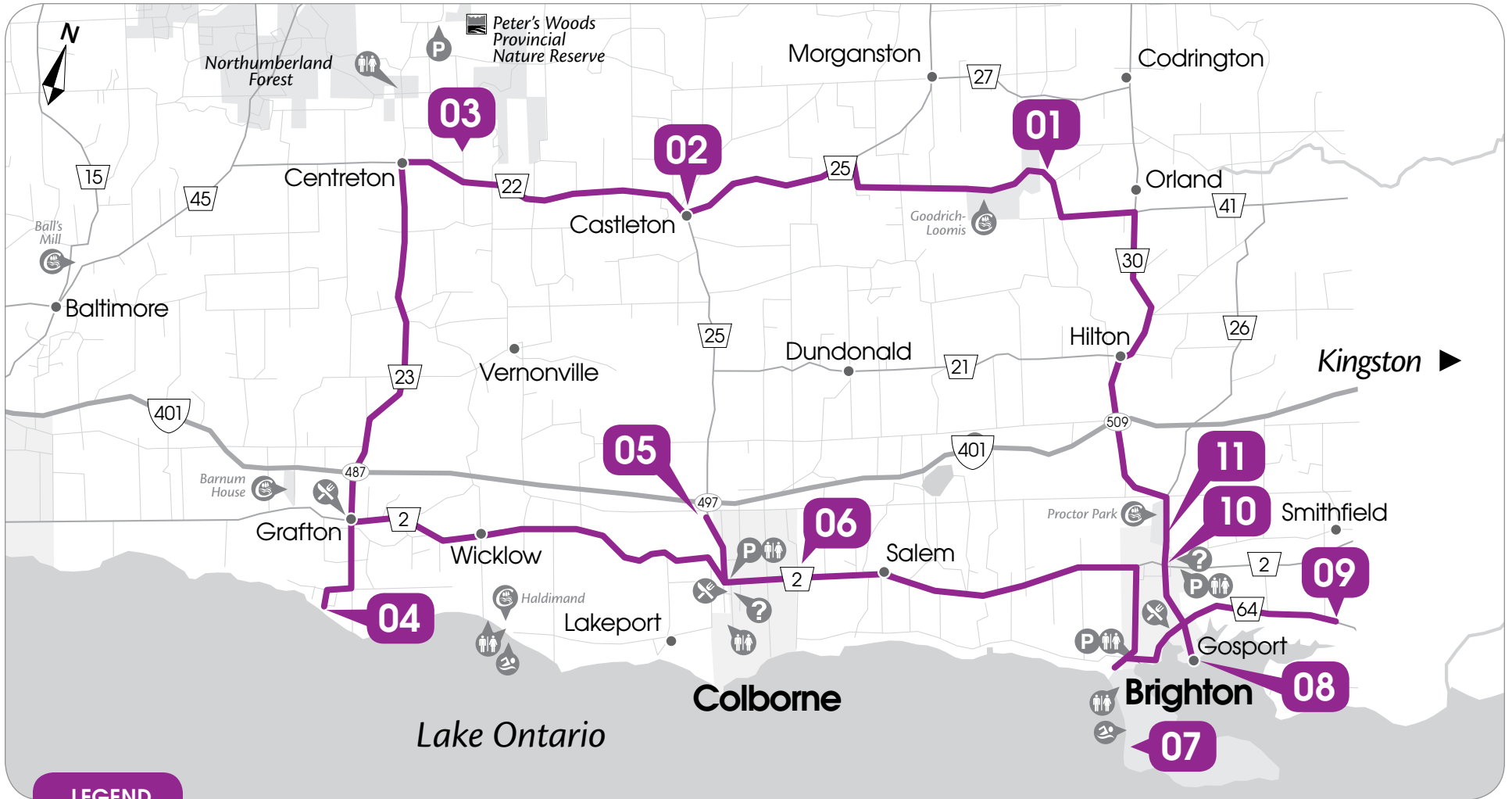
