01 William Weller Plaque 


North end of Victoria Park
King St., Cobourg

Sink your toes into Cobourg Beach, then head to Victoria Park to find out about William Weller (three-time Mayor of Cobourg) and his record-breaking stagecoach drive in 1840.

02 St. Peter's Anglican Church 

240 College St., Cobourg

Admire the magnificent architecture of 1850s Early Gothic Revival style at St. Peter's Anglican Church.

03 Cobourg Harbour 

The Esplanade, Cobourg

Admire the yachts at the Cobourg Harbour, where the first pier was built in 1829.

04 Cobourg Farmers' Market

110 Albert St., Cobourg

Take in the Saturday Farmers' Market along Albert Street. See seasonal hours below.

05 Victoria Hall 


55 King St. W., Cobourg

Strike a pose beside the Corinthian columns at Victoria Hall, or step into the grand ballroom.

06 Heritage District

King St. West & East, Cobourg

Discover the galleries, shops and local bistros downtown in the Heritage District.

07 Lakefront Gazebo 

Plank & Kelly Rds., Gore's Landing

On County Rd. 18, northbound at Gore's Landing, pull over for a magnificent view of Rice Lake and then head downhill. Before reaching the lakefront gazebo, you'll have a chance to learn about the former well-known residents of the area.

08 Rice Lake Inns & Cottage Resorts

Rice Lake Scenic Drive, Gore's Landing

Linger longer at an inn or cottage resort along Rice Lake's pristine shores.

09 Cobourg-Peterborough Railroad Causeway Plaque 

Front St., Harwood

Drive to the waterfront community of Harwood and learn about the former Cobourg to Peterborough rail line, one of Canada's earliest.

10 Roseneath Carousel*

9109 County Rd. 45, Roseneath

Take your favourite handcrafted horse for a whirl on a 1906 covered carousel in Roseneath.

11 Alderville First Nation Black Oak Savanna*

8796 County Rd. 18, Alderville

Visit the Alderville First Nation Black Oak Savanna to see the largest tract of native grassland habitat in Central Ontario.

12 PrimRose Donkey Sanctuary

1296 Bowmanton Rd., Roseneath


Stop into the PrimRose Donkey Sanctuary - a special place dedicated to the rescue, protection and rehabilitation of unwanted donkeys. Also meet the mules, miniature horses, sheep, goats, and others.

13 Northumberland County Forest

Beagle Club Rd., Centreton

Spot unique birds and wildlife in Northumberland County Forest.

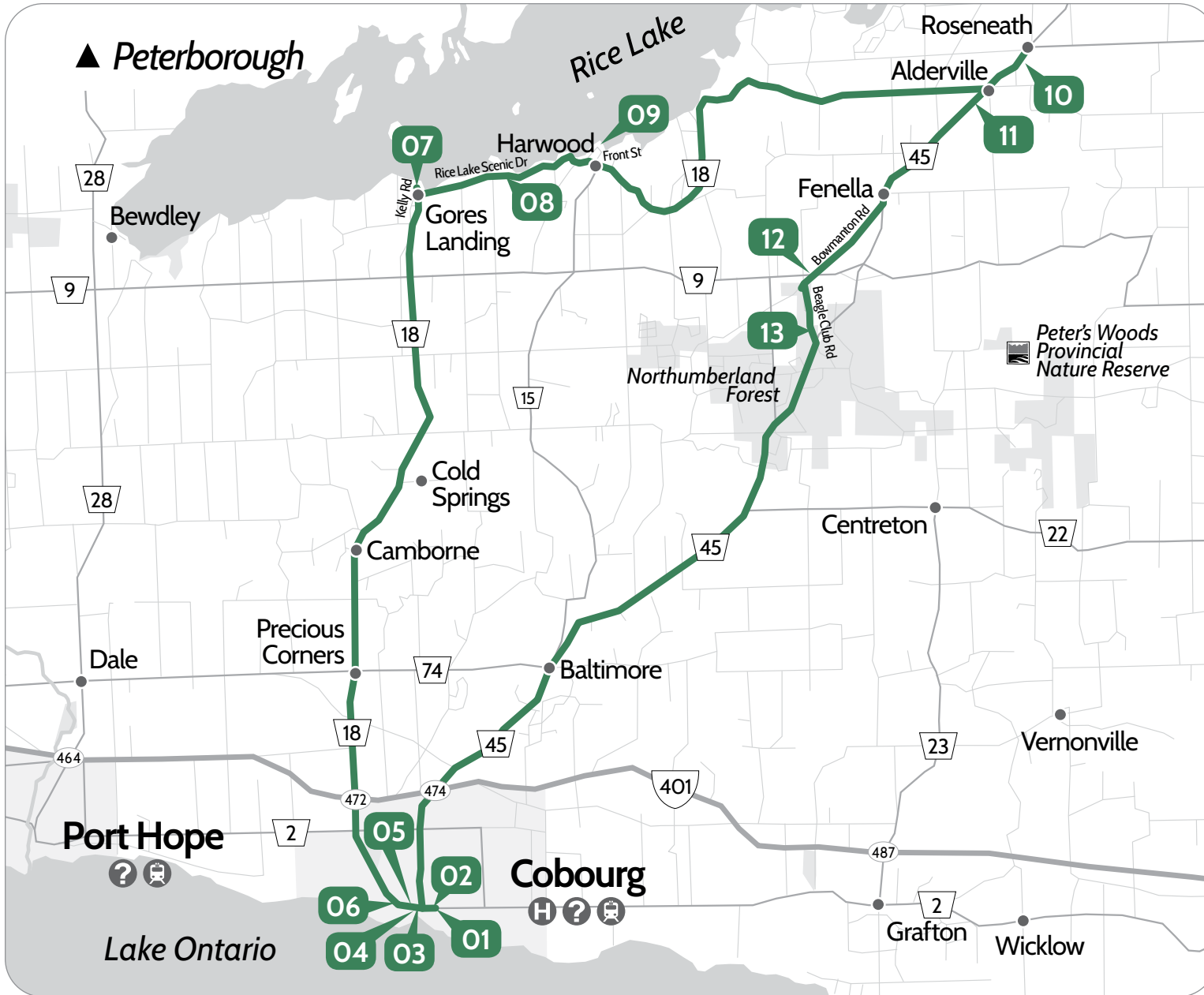
