01 1812 Heritage Building

105 Old Danforth Rd., Grafton

Start your tour at Grafton's 1812 Heritage Building with its historic shops with books, cards and antiques.

02 Grafton Town Hall 

10836 County Rd. 2, Grafton

Visit Grafton's Town Hall designated a special heritage site. Nearby, the Grafton Village Inn has welcomed guests since 1820.

03 Barnum House Museum 

10568 County Rd. 2, Grafton

West of Grafton, view Barnum House Museum, restored in 1820s style. (Exterior viewing only.)

04 Ste. Anne's Spa

1009 Massey Rd., Grafton

Go west on County Rd. 2, then head north on Gully Rd. and turn right onto Massey Rd. to reach the world-famous Ste. Anne's Spa

05 Peter's Woods Provincial Nature Reserve

McDonald Rd., Centreton

Stretch your legs with a short looped hike at Peter's Woods Provincial Nature Reserve Trail in a sole-surviving Oak Ridges Moraine old-growth forest.

06 Villa Conti Oak Heights Estate Winery

337 Covert Hill Rd., Warkworth

Just off County Rd. 29, try rustic Italian fare at Villa Conti Oak Heights Estate Winery.

07 J.D. Kelly Plaque 

Mill St. & Old Hastings Rd., Warkworth

At Mill St. and Old Hasting's Rd. in Warkworth, learn about J.D. Kelly, a gifted painter and illustrator.

08 Frantic Farms Clay & Glass & Gallery

2 Mill St., Warkworth

In the artists' enclave of Warkworth, talk to artisans on the main street, or see Monica work her magic at her pottery wheel at Frantic Farms Clay & Glass & Gallery.

09 Cafés & Artisan Shops

Main St., Warkworth

Visit welcoming cafés & other shops on Warkworth's Main St. Have a steaming latté or browse the very cool nearby stores.

10 Arts & Heritage Centre of Warkworth

35 Church St., Warkworth


Say Ah! Be inspired at the Arts & Heritage Centre of Warkworth.

11 Cuttle Cottage Lavender*

295 Vernonville Rd., Grafton

Wander through a field of lavender, get eggs, plants and unique hostess gifts at Cuttle Cottage Lavender.

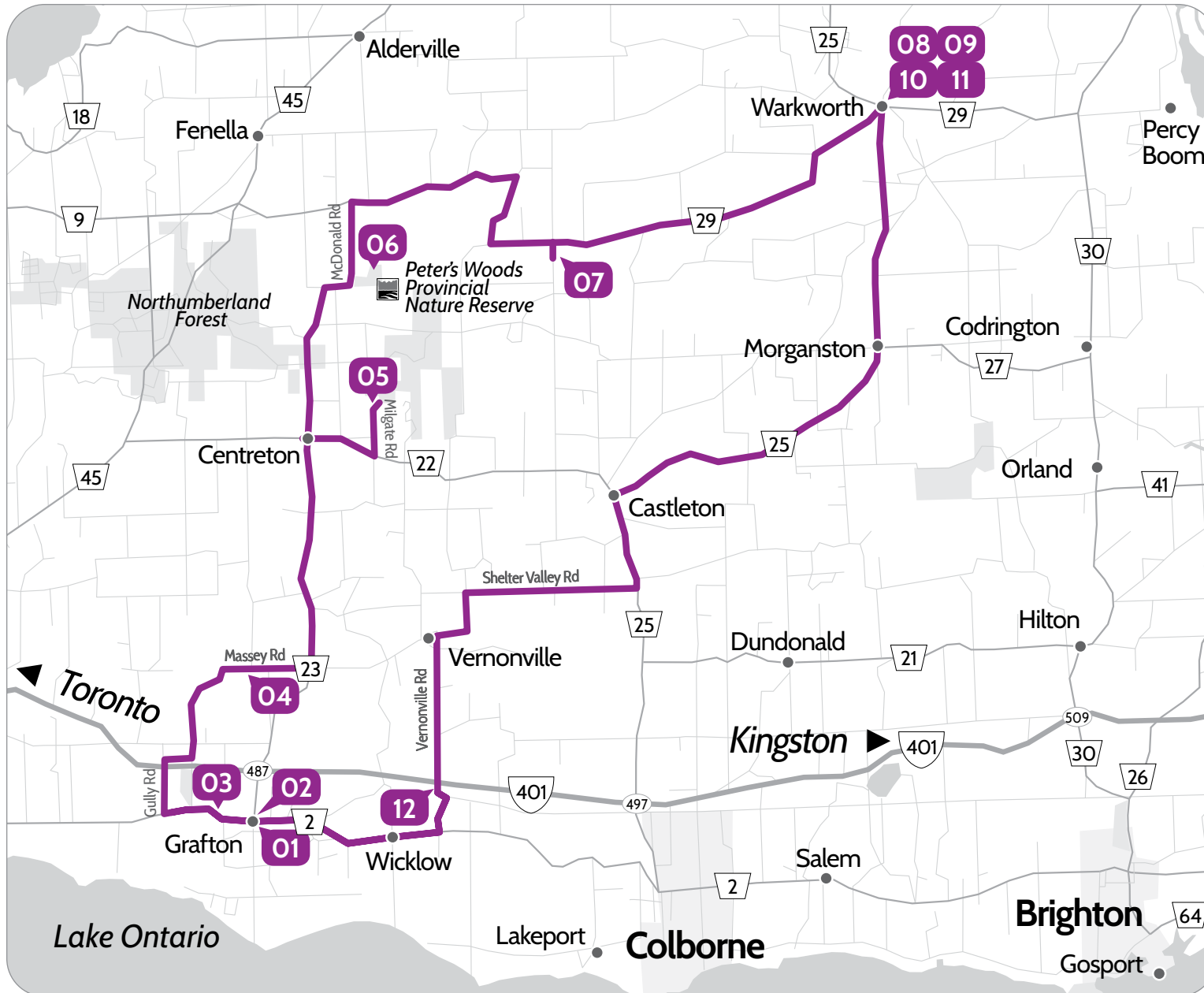
