01 Village of Hastings Founders Plaque 

Front St. W., Hastings

Start at the Village of Hastings. Visit the park on the Trent River to read why this village became a hub of the Trent-Severn Waterway.

02 Banjo's Grill

3 Bridge St. S., Hastings

Enjoy great homemade fare at Banjo's Grill beside Lock 18 on the Trent River.

03 Trans Canada Trail

Cedar Dr., Hastings

Park south of Banjo's Grill where you'll find a map of the Trans Canada Trail to walk or cycle.

04 Curles Maple Products

726 8th Line W., Campbellford

Go south on Hwy. 30 to Curles Maple Products to pick up maple syrup and more. Please call ahead. 705-653-2519

05 Church-Key Pub & Grindhouse & Capers Restaurant (next door)

26 Bridge St. W., Campbellford

Try craft beer on tap at Church-Key Pub & Grindhouse or enjoy the patio next door at Capers.

06 Dooher's Bakery

61 Bridge St. E., Campbellford

Take Campbellford's main bridge to Dooher's Bakery on Main St., famous for their donuts since 1955.

07 Church-Key Brewing

1678 County Rd. 38, Campbellford

Discover award-winning craft beer at Church-Key Brewing located in a former Methodist church. Have a tour and take home some unique varieties.

08 Empire Cheese Co-operative

1120 County Rd. 8, Campbellford

Head south on Pethericks Rd. to County Rd. 8. Look for Empire Cheese Co-operative to get cheese curd so fresh it's still warm, or pick from more than 20 varieties of cheddar made on site.

09 World's Finest Chocolate Outlet Store

157 Cockburn St., Campbellford

Back through Campbellford, stop into the World's Finest Chocolate Outlet Store for tasty caramel whirls and mint meltaways.

10 Ranney Gorge Suspension Bridge & Ranney Falls

15 Trent Dr., Campbellford

Locks 11 & 12, Campbellford

Test your love of heights at the Ranney Gorge Suspension Bridge on foot or by bike, and take in a view of Ranney Falls.

11 Glover's Farm Market

14260 County Rd. 29, Warkworth

West on County Rd. 29, stop at Glover's Farm Market – to purchase fresh-baked pies, treats, and locally-raised black angus beef and lamb.

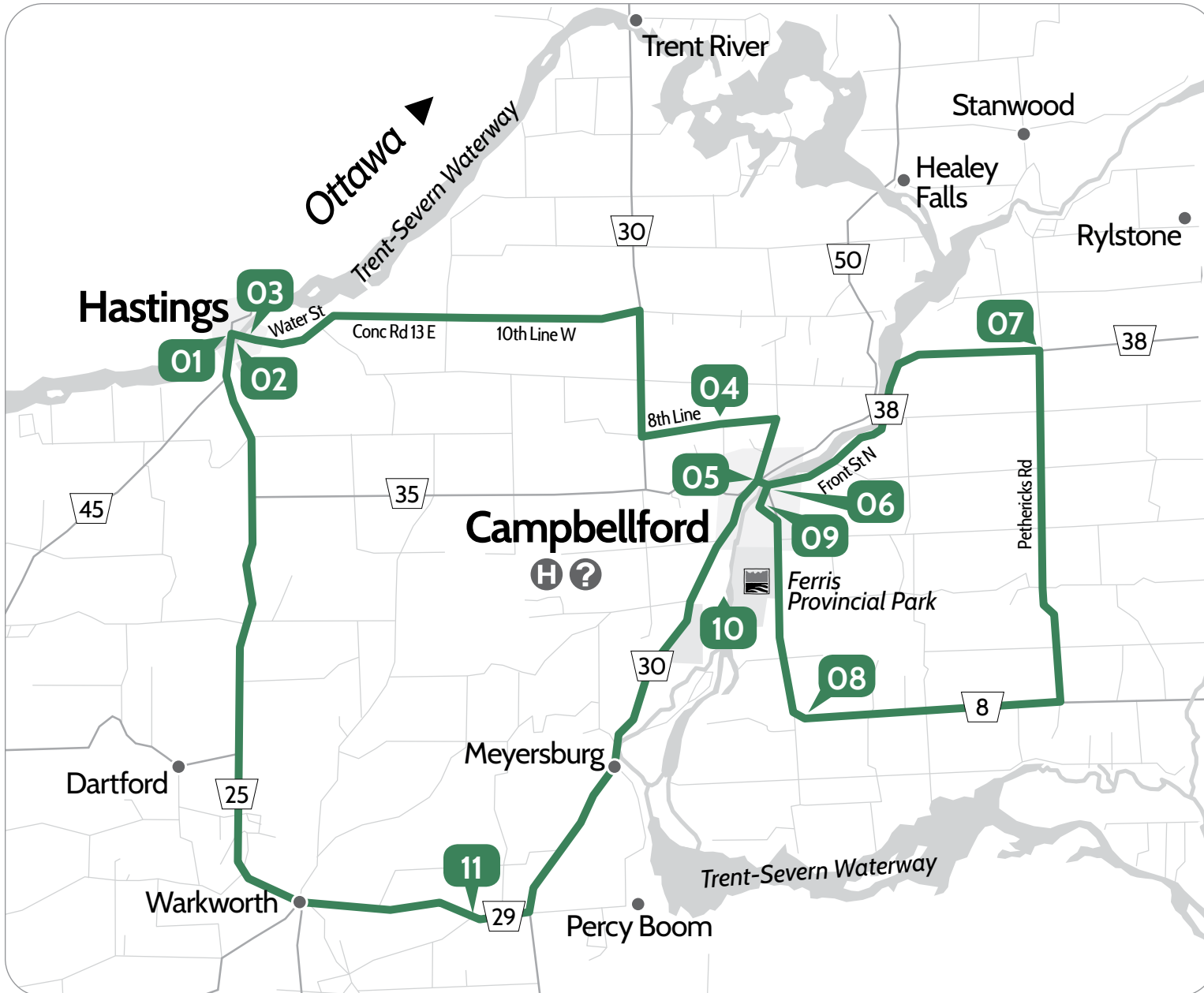
