**01 Colborne Art Gallery**  
51 King St. E., Colborne

Start your tour in the village of Colborne. Stop into the Colborne Art Gallery to see contemporary visual arts.

**02 Joseph Keeler Plaque**  
Victoria Square, Percy St., Colborne

Find the Joseph Keeler Plaque in Colborne's Victoria Park and learn how this early settlement town was founded in 1819.

**03 Wicklow Boat Launch**  
Lakeport Rd., Lakeport

Stop at Wicklow Boat Launch to enjoy a picnic and scenic views of Lake Ontario.

**04 Wicklow Beach**  
Lakeport Rd., Lakeport

Near Lakeport, stroll along Wicklow Beach and identify the unique varieties of birds.

**05 The Big Apple**  
262 Orchard Rd., Colborne

At The Big Apple, climb the interior stairs 35 feet up to the top of the world's biggest apple. In the store, you can watch apple pies being baked, dine and visit the cidery.

**06 Scenic Views**  
Telephone Rd., Colborne

Take a scenic hills drive and enjoy a roller coaster car ride along Telephone Rd.

**07 The Apple Route**  
Highway 2, Brighton & Area

Discover what has long been known as Ontario's Apple Route on County Rd. 2 between Port Hope and Brighton. Stop at the orchards and farm stands along the way.

**08 Town of Brighton & Shops**  
Main St., Brighton

Enjoy the quaint Town of Brighton and its shops and boutiques.

**09 Proctor House Museum\* & Proctor-Simpson Barn**  
96 Young St., Brighton

Tour a mid-1800s house, now the Proctor House Museum, and visit the Proctor-Simpson Barn theatre next door. Or, consider a short forested hike just north of the theatre building.

**10 Memory Junction Museum\***  
60 Maplewood Ave., Brighton

See over 5,000 pieces of memorabilia at Memory Junction Museum including an old caboose and a 1906 steam engine.

**11 Presqu'île Provincial Park**  
328 Presqu'île Parkway, Brighton

Explore the marsh boardwalk at Presqu'île Provincial Park. Read the plaque on the "loss of the Speedy" a schooner that sank in 1814.

**12 Farm Fresh Fruit & Vegetable Stands\***  
Highway 2, Brighton & Area

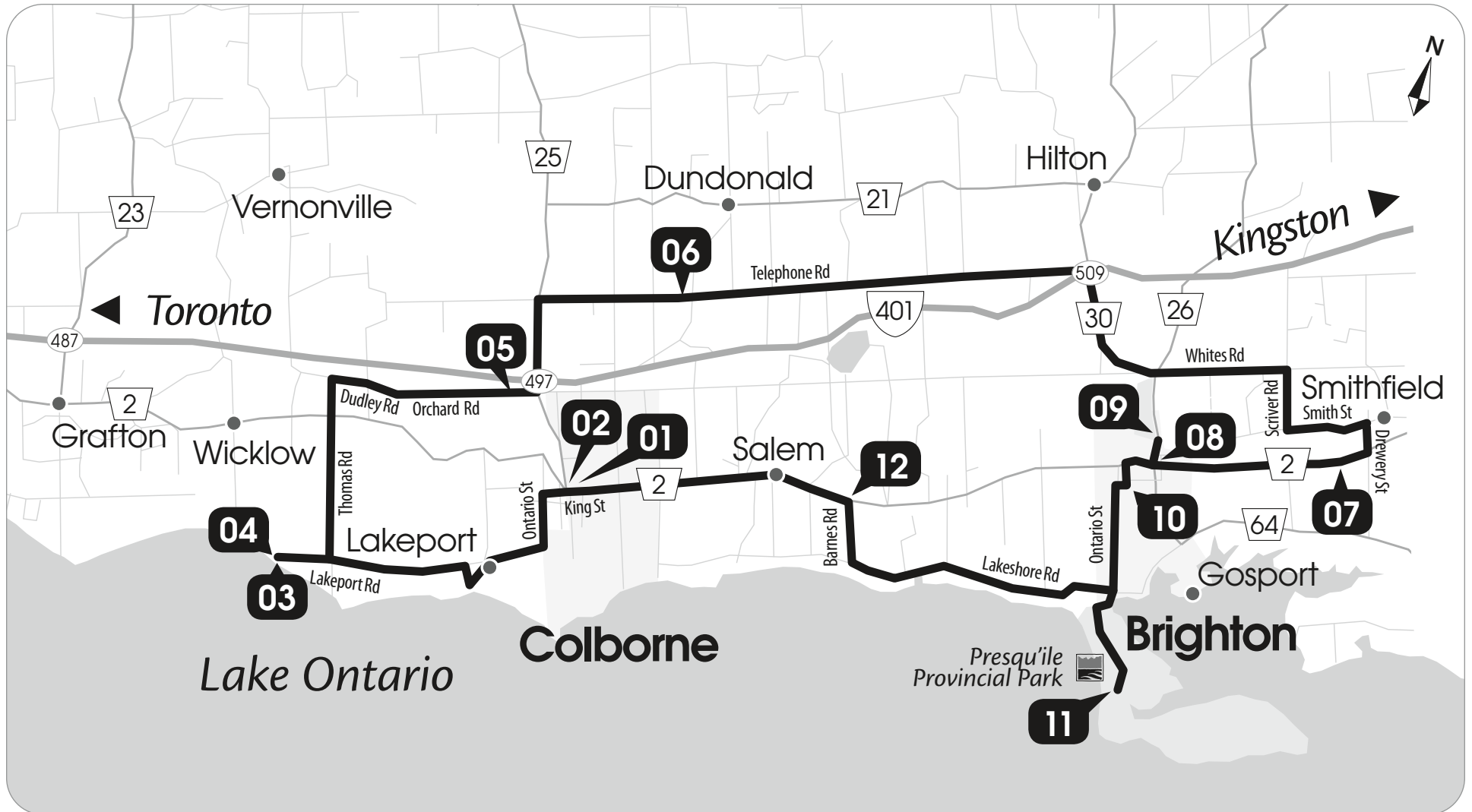
Visit the many fruit and vegetable stands that dot this route to find everything in season from corn to kale.
